

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY

BY-LAW NUMBER 21 - 2011

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law Number 95-2006, being a by-law to establish a system for the registration of security alarm systems and reduction of false alarms for enforcement by the West Grey Police Service;

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, a municipality and a local board may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons, subject to certain conditions;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT section 13 of By-law No. 95-2006 is hereby deleted, and replaced by the following clause:

“13. Where an Alarm Registration Certificate has not been issued for the Security Alarm System responsible for the False Alarm, the appropriate registration fees, calculated in accordance with Appendix A, shall be added to the charge imposed pursuant to paragraph 12. Fees under this section shall be the responsibility of the owner of the building, property, structure or premises. Upon payment of this fee and any outstanding amounts incurred as a result of a False Alarm, the Chief of Police shall cause the Security Alarm System to be entered in the Security Alarm System Registry and an Alarm Registration Certificate shall be issued.”

2. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing

Read a first and second time this 4th day of April, 2011.

Read a third time and finally passed, this 4th day of April, 2011.
