

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 24 - 2009**

**BEING** a By-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 37-2006, of the Municipality of West Grey;

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey deems it in the public interest to pass a By-law to amend By-law No. 37-2006;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, By-laws may be amended by Councils of Municipalities;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. By-law No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by affecting the lands described as Part Lots 17 & 18, Concession 5, in the Municipality of West Grey, former Township of Glenelg, and shown more particularly as the Subject Property on Schedule “18B” attached hereto.
2. Schedule “18” to By-law No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by changing the zone symbol on the retained parcel from the Rural (A2) Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone to the Rural (A2-272) Exception Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone; as shown on Schedule “18B affixed hereto.
3. Section 35 to By-law No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“35.272

Notwithstanding any provision in By-law No. 37-2006 to the contrary, the barn existing as of the date of passage of this by-law shall be permitted to be used for dry storage only.”

4. Schedule “18B” and all other notations thereon are hereby declared to form part of this By-law.
5. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon being passed by Council subject to any approval necessary pursuant to the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

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Read a first and second time this 20<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2009.

Read a third time and finally passed this 20<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2009.

**NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW**  
**BY THE CORPORATION OF THE**  
**MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey passed By-law Number 24 - 2009 on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2009, under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the Zoning By-law may be appealed to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey not later than the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the fee prescribed under the Ontario Municipal Board Act, S.O. 1994.

**ONLY** individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a Zoning By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf.

**IF** a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Municipality of West Grey in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law, does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Municipality of West Grey before the proposed Zoning By-law is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

**AN EXPLANATION** of the purpose and effect of the By-law, describing the lands to which the By-law applies, and a Key Map showing the location of the lands to which the By-law applies are attached. The complete By-law is available for inspection in my office during regular business hours.

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This By-law applies only to those lands located within the former Township of Glenelg, and described as Part Lots 17 & 18, Concession 5, as shown on Schedule "18B" affixed hereto.

The purpose of this By-law is to implement a condition of consent application B26/2008.

The effect of this By-law is to rezone the retained parcel from the Rural (A2) Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone to the Rural (A2-272) Exception Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone; as shown on Schedule "18B" affixed hereto. Exception 272 shall only permit the barn existing as of the date of passage of this by-law to be used for dry storage only

The County of Grey Official Plan places the subject lands within the "Rural" and "Hazard Lands" land use designations.

The Council of the Municipality of West Grey has adopted this By-law and is now circulating it in accordance with Provincial Regulations.
