

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY

BY-LAW NUMBER 33 - 2009

BEING a By-law to control the placement of Electronic Waste - E-Waste at the Bentinck, Durham and Normanby Landfill Sites, and on any properties within the Municipality of West Grey;

WHEREAS UNDER Section 9 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001 as amended Municipalities are empowered to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate; and;

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of West Grey deems it expedient to divert and control Electronic Waste - E-Waste from being placed at the Bentinck, Durham and Normanby Landfill Sites; and;

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of West Grey wishes to eliminate the potential for hazardous contaminants entering the Bentinck, Durham and Normanby Landfill Sites;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall illegally place Electronic Waste – E-Waste at the Bentinck, Durham and Normanby landfill sites.
2. No person shall place, throw or deposit Electronic Waste – E-Waste on any properties within the Municipality, other than those designated by the Municipality of West Grey.
3. Electronic Waste - E-Waste is defined as those materials listed on Schedule “A” attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
4. Electronic Waste – E-Waste shall be received of at 590 Park Street, Durham landfill site; specific area location established to receive such waste.
5. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalties under the Provincial Offences Act and to the set fines as listed on Schedule “B” attached hereto.
6. That this by-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a FIRST AND SECOND time this 21st day of May, 2009.

READ a THIRD time and finally passed this 21st day of May, 2009.
