

**CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 73 - 2010**

**BEING**, a By-law to appoint a Deputy Chief Building Official for the purpose of the enforcement of the Building Code Act S.O. 1992 c.23, as amended;

**WHEREAS**, Section 3 (2) of the Building Code Act S.O. 1992 c.23, as amended, establishes that the council of each municipality shall appoint a chief building official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction

**AND WHEREAS**, the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, section 227, establishes the role of the officers and employees of the municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That in conjunction with the reciprocity agreement attached as Schedule 'A' , the Municipality hereby appoint a Deputy Chief Building Official for the Municipality of West Grey, on a temporary part-time contract basis.
2. That the terms of the reciprocity agreement and name of CBO identified in the agreement shall be accepted and deemed binding by reciprocating Municipalities.
3. That the agreement can be terminated at any time by either party with 60days written notice.
4. That this By-law shall be deemed to come into full force and effect on the date of its passing thereof.

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Read a first and second time this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010.

Read a third time and finally passed this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010.

**SCHEDULE 'A'**

**DEPUTY CHIEF BUILDING OFFICIAL RECIPROCIITY AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE MUNICIPALITIES OF**

**THE MUNICIPALITY of GREY HIGHLANDS & THE MUNICIPALITY of  
WEST GREY**

Being, an agreement to enact the Chief Building Official of the MUNICIPALITY OF GREY HIGHLANDS and the Chief Building Official of the MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY to serve in the capacity of Deputy CBO as defined under the Building Code Act S.O. 1992 c.23 as amended; in the absence of either Municipal CBO, this agreement shall define the terms of the reciprocal arrangement.

The purpose of this agreement is to assist each Municipality with specific personnel coverage during holidays and short term illness.

The coverage is considered reciprocal with no time invoice up to and including eighty (80) hours per calendar year. It is agreed that if more than eighty hours is required, a contract invoice will be submitted for recovery of time spent at a rate of \$35.00 dollars per hour.

It is agreed by both Municipalities that; reimbursement for mileage to conduct inspections, shall be invoiced separately, and will be paid a rate consistent with the County of Grey standard mileage rate chart.

This agreement may be amended from time to time with written signed acceptance to the amendment(s) by both parties.

This agreement may be terminated by rescinding the By-Law which enacted this agreement, as per the terms of the By-Law.
