

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 68 - 2013**

**BEING** a By-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 37-2006, of the Municipality of West Grey;

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey deems it in the public interest to pass a By-law to amend By-law No. 37-2006;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, By-laws may be amended by Councils of Municipalities;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. By-law No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by affecting the lands described as Part Lot 1, Concession 8, in the Municipality of West Grey, former Township of Normanby, and shown more particularly on Schedule “39B”.
2. Schedule “39B” to By-law No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by changing the zone symbol on the subject property from the Agricultural (A1) Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone, to the Agricultural Exception (A1-329) Zone, Agricultural Exception with holding provisions (A1-329-h) Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone, for the retained parcel, as shown on Schedule “39B” as affixed hereto.
3. Section 35 to By-law No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:  
  
“35.329  
  
Notwithstanding Subsection 8.2.1 and of By-law No. 37-2006 to the contrary, the following provisions shall apply to the lands zoned Agricultural (A1-329) as shown on Schedule “39B” affixed hereto:  
  
(i) Minimum Lot Area – 19.9 hectares;  
  
(ii) The ‘h’ suffix (“holding” symbol) attached to certain lands zoned A1-329 shall only be removed once it has been demonstrated through an Environmental Impact Study to the satisfaction of the Municipality of West Grey and the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority that site alteration or development within this area will not negatively impact upon the ecological functions of the Significant Woodlands and their adjacent lands.
4. Notwithstanding subsection 6.20.2 of By-law No. 37-2006 to the contrary, lands within the Natural Environment (NE) Zone shall be included in the calculation of lot area for the lands subject to this By-law.
5. Schedule “39B” and all other notations thereon are hereby declared to form part of this By-law.
6. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon being passed by Council subject to any approval necessary pursuant to the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

**NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW**  
**BY THE CORPORATION OF THE**  
**MUNICIPALITY OF WEST GREY**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey passed By-law Number 68 - 2013 on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2013, under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the Zoning By-law may be appealed to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey not later than the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2013, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the fee prescribed under the Ontario Municipal Board Act, S.O. 1994.

**ONLY** individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a Zoning By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf.

**IF** a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Municipality of West Grey in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law, does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Municipality of West Grey before the proposed Zoning By-law is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

**AN EXPLANATION** of the purpose and effect of the By-law, describing the lands to which the By-law applies, and a Key Map showing the location of the lands to which the By-law applies are attached. The complete By-law is available for inspection in my office during regular business hours.

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This By-law applies only to those lands located within the former Township of Normanby, and described as Part Lot 1, Concession 8, as shown on Schedule “39B” affixed hereto.

The purpose of this By-law is to implement a condition of consent application B05/2013.

The effect of this By-law is to rezone the subject lands from the Agricultural (A1) Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone to the Agricultural Exception (A1-329) Zone, Agricultural Exception with Holding Provisions (A1-329-h) Zone and Natural Environment (NE) Zone for the severed parcel, as shown on Schedule “39B”. Exception 329 recognizes the deficient lot area of the subject property. The ‘h’ suffix (“holding” symbol) has been attached to certain lands zoned A1-329 and shall only be removed once it has been demonstrated through an Environmental Impact Study to the satisfaction of the Municipality of West Grey and the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority that site alteration or development within this area will not negatively impact upon the ecological functions of the Significant Woodlands and their adjacent lands.

The County of Grey Official Plan places the subject lands within the “Agricultural” and “Hazard Lands” land use designations.

The Council of the Municipality of West Grey has adopted this By-law and is now circulating it in accordance with Provincial Regulations.
