# Telephone Voting

To initiate a Telephone voting session, the voter will require:

- A touch-tone home telephone, cellular phone OR smart phone
- The information contained on their Voter Information Letter, including the toll free phone number, their Voter ID and PIN number

**Rotary phones will not work. Party lines are strongly discouraged for use.**

The voter starts the telephone voting process by dialing the toll free number found on the Voter Information Letter

# Telephone Voting

The voter is prompted to enter their Month and Year of Birth.



“Please enter your Year of Birth.”

# Telephone Voting

The voter's credentials are validated.

“Your voter credentials are being validated.”

Once the voter's credentials have been validated:

- Welcome message is played.
- System indicates the races available to be voted.
- The voter is provided with instructions on how to vote using the Telephone in order to complete their ballot.
- The Voting system proceeds to the first contest on the ballot.

Vote for Mayor

Voter selects option “2”.

Voter selects option “#”.

Voter is taken to the next contest on the ballot.

# Telephone Voting

Vote for Deputy Mayor

“To vote for:

- Edith Edwards Press 2
- Francis Franks Press 3”



Voter selects option “1”.

# Telephone Voting

Vote for Deputy Mayor – cancelling a selection

Voter selects option \* key.

“To vote for:

- Helen Heart      Press 2
- Ingrid Ink      Press 3
- John Johnston      Press 4
- Karen Karns      Press 5
- Larry Loner      Press 6
- Mary Motts      Press 7



Voter selects option “2”.

# Telephone Voting

## Vote for Councillors



“You have selected Helen Heart as your choice number 1.”

“If this is correct, press the # key.”

“To cancel this selection, press the \* key.”



Voter selects option “#” .

Voter is prompted to make additional selections.

# Telephone Voting

## Vote for Councillors



“Please make your second selection now. If you have no further selections, please press the # key twice.”

“To Vote for:

- Greg Ground      Press 1
- Ingrid Ink        Press 3
- John Johnston    Press 4
- Karen Karns      Press 5
- Larry Loner       Press 6
- Mary Motts        Press 7”

The voter continues to make their selections until they have selected the maximum number of candidates for the Councillors.



# Telephone Voting

## Vote for Councillors



“To complete voting in this contest and review your selections, please press the # key twice.”



Voter presses “# #”.

# Telephone Voting

## Vote for Councillors



“You have selected:

- Helen Heart
- Ingrid Ink
- John Johnston
- Karen Karns
- Larry Loner

“If this is correct, press the # key.”

“To cancel these selections and start over, press the \* key.”

Voter selects option “#”.

The voter is taken to the School Board race and selects their choices in the same manner. Once the voter has completed all the races they are taken to the ballot review.



# Telephone Voting

## Ballot Review



“You have finished voting. All your selections will be read to you now.”

“Mayor: You have selected Brian Burns. To complete voting in this contest, please press the # key. To clear this selection and restart voting for this contest press the \* key.”

The voter accepts the selection of each race by pressing the # key.

This is repeated for all races.

# Telephone Voting

## Cast Your Ballot



Once the voter has completed the ballot review and has accepted all their choices, they will cast their ballot, and receive the message:

“You have successfully cast your ballot.”  
“Thank you for voting.”



The voter is now struck off the eligible Voters’ List and disconnected from the voting system.
