- The showers in dressing room have been repaired and new set of battery power faucet.
- West Grey Minor Hockey is winding up this Sat. April 16 with 3 hours ice skating and registration for next season. We have a two day tournament on April 2nd & 3rd that is WOAA Midget Girls they have booked 17 hours ice time.
- The Arena has switched over the internet service from Bruce Telecom for the office computer and Xplornet V-fi and also with the Bell Canada phone services to Eastlink as of March 28. We now have stronger and faster internet provider. We will be saving about \$ 2,000.00 year by switching over.
