

Minutes of the Neustadt Recreation Advisory Committee
Oct. 12, 2016

The Neustadt Recreation Advisory Committee met on Wednesday Oct. 12th at 7:00 PM in the Community Hall Meeting Room with Carol Lawrence- Council Rep, Brenda Foerster, Kathy Weber, Brian Zettler, and Don Zettler present. Absent Nelson Granger, Audrey Filsinger, and Tom Culliton.

Kelly Lantz from Botanical Designs made a presentation on possible changes to the pond in the Lions Park. A costly new liner is needed which brought about the suggested changes which would also eliminate liability from open water. The remake could be done by the end of October if council's approval given.

Chair Don opened the meeting and welcomed all. He asked if there were any pecuniary interests in the proceedings. Kathy declared. Minutes of the Sept. 14th meeting were read by Don Zettler. Minutes were approved after an amendment on a motion by Brenda Foerster and seconded by Brian.

Business From Minutes: The wooden bridge in the park will be repaired next spring. Cutlery in the kitchen was checked and noted that there are 14 different patterns. A total inventory of the kitchen should be done before the new year.

Christmas in the Village: The committee is waiting to see what the Business Group have in mind for this year.

Lions Park Pond: It is recommended by the committee that the proposed changes as presented by Kelly Lantz be carried out with the added cost of removing the lilac hedge behind the pond. Improvements to the Soccer Pitch and bleachers were discussed as a project from the fund raising.
