- Chad met with the in-field diamond guy Blair from Marco and discussed the conditions of the diamond and he provided some quotes
- He gave some recommendations; lip between in-field and grass should be addressed especially on B diamond; strongly recommends education before putting money out; lay the ground work; training is important for the maintenance; training course costs \$1000.00 he would come up for the day but other centres could be invited to attend to help offset the cost; if we host the training it would be our own diamonds that we would work on; equipment would need to be rented for the course
- The intent is to do the fundraising and apply for grants to cover the costs for improvements and enhancements

- The committee believes that lighting is the biggest need for the diamonds but there has also been a request put in for the tennis courts
- Randy came in under budget so hopefully the \$17,000 will be approved;

- We need to work together on these improvements and enhancements;
   there is a meeting in the early spring that Randy will be invited to so that he is a part of the process
- Randy is attending a meeting on December 16<sup>th</sup> in Milverton and he will mention the possibility of us holding a training session to gauge interest; the Diamond Project Committee will prepare a flyer for Randy to take with him or check with Blair to see if he already has something that could be used
- The goal is for the Playground installation to take place by the end of May or beginning of June

#### Arena:

- Brine pump motor is now back in operation.
- ➤ Had issue with brakes this month with the Ice Resurfacer. Had replaced the brake booster on the machine.
- > We have installed new sign rental on the rink boards for Food Land last week.
- > West Grey Minor has Bantam Rep tournament Sat. Nov. 26 with eight teams.
- > Tim Hortons has sponsored 10 hour for their free holiday skate starting Dec. 27<sup>th</sup> 28<sup>th</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> from 12 to 1:30 pm Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> from 6:30 to 8:30 pm and Jan.2<sup>nd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 to 1:30 pm. Eastlink has sponsored free skate for Jan.7<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 to 8pm.
- > Tennis courts are closed up for the season nets were taken down and sun screens also were taken down and stored here at the arena.
- The ball diamond expenditure was increased by 500.00 for total \$ 4500.00 to pouches 50 gal water tanks for the drag and a Diamond Rakes and couple of other tools.
- ➤ I receive a quote from John Rydall to cleanup and repair the bricks at the Durham Town Hall for \$ 2000.00. This will not be a capital item now I added \$ 3000.00 to the building maintenance expenditure.
- New Heights Building gave me quote to replace the siding at south end of the arena for \$10520.00 I had to increase this part of the capital budget by \$ 2500.00. They recommend removing the existing steel.
