

# Neustadt Recreation Advisory Committee

April 12, 2017 – Meeting Minutes

The Neustadt Recreation Advisory Committee met on Wednesday April 12, 2017 at 7:00 pm in the Neustadt Community Centre.

Vice Chair Kathy called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

**Declaration of Pecuniary Interest:** None

**Minutes:** Minutes of the March 8, 2017 meeting were read by Nelson. Moved by Rheo, Seconded by Audrey that the minutes be approved. Carried.

**Business from Minutes:** Carol reported that on April 3<sup>rd</sup> council passed a motion to hire a second cruiser for roller skating. Also approved increase in admission for adults from \$3.00 to \$4.00 per person, children under 13 remains at \$2.00 and roller skate rental moves to \$2.00 for all ages. Increases to be effective June 3, 2017. Discussion on behaviours of some younger skaters and the problems they are creating was held. Tom read a letter from a concerned citizen on the same matter. Suggested measures that could be taken to alleviate the problem were discussed. Tom will deal with it.

Courtney reported that she is still working on providing pickelball for adults with disabilities. It has to be on an evening or weekend. When ball hockey ends there should be an opening.

Rheo reported that 50 kids had signed up for soccer. There will be local plus two travelling teams of 8-10 year olds going between Tara to Teeswater.

**Vouchers:** Moved by Nelson, Seconded by Audrey that vouchers V04-V06 be approved for payment. Carried.

**Correspondence:** March 1 and 28 Normanby minutes and Durham Mar 23 were distributed February minutes of the Durham Rec Committee were distributed.

## **Committee Reports:**

**Pickelball:** Nelson turned in \$1043.00 for the period Mar 17 to Apr 12 and reported there are now 102 members. Some snowbirds back, still more to come. The lines for the 6<sup>th</sup> court have not been painted yet. Need approximately 3 days with no functions on the floor. Tom stated there could be a window of opportunity in May.


**Roller Skating:** 864 skaters in March. \$2,622.00 in revenue. Numbers vary from 131 per night to 213.

**Craft Show:** Kathy turned in ~~\$2998.00~~<sup>2917.00</sup> in cash and cheques for rental of vendor's booths. Organization well under way. There are still a few spots open. Set up will be Thursday May 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. Those helping Kathy will be Zach, Rheo, Courtnee and Brian. On door on May 6<sup>th</sup> Carol 9:30-1:30 Courtnee 9:30-11:30, Zach 11:30-1:30, Brian & Mary 1:30-3:30. Take down at 4:30 – Courtnee, Rheo and a group organized by Rheo. Vendor set up is Friday May 5<sup>th</sup> 2-4 and 7-9. Kathy will oversee that.

**Tom's Report:** There will now be 6 groups playing on the ball diamond for the season. The parking lot paving to be done soon. Possibly in June. Have to wait till craft show and lobsterfest is over. Tenders to go out soon for painting of arena ceiling.
