Items of Business

Director of Infrastructure & Public Works Report

The Road Tour included the following itinerary:

Durham - George Street Pump Station-review of capital upgrades; George Street – proposed 2017 hot mix resurfacing Last improvement 1962; Queen Street- proposed 2017 resurfacing Last improvement 1981; George Street- proposed catch basin & curb and spot repairs; Durham – new sidewalk proposal – Lambton Street and service to Library; Durham Waste Water Treatment Plant-review of plant and UV location proposal; Old County Shed-review storage shed proposal.

The Committee of the Whole requested the Director to obtain a quote to construct a new 3 bay structure for storage purposes on the old County Shed property.

Bentinck - Concession 2 WGR-review 2018 proposed work - last improvement 1994; Crawford Bridges-proposed 2017 safety approach work; Mary Rutherford's 10 Sd Rd-review of illegal dump site; 5th Sd. Rd.- consideration for hard topping upon road rationalization review; Sd. Rd. 10

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from concession 14 to Townline-review of illegal dump site; Concession 4 NDR-from Grey Rd. 10 east 3.5km - proposed 2017 resurfacing. Last improvement 1999; Concession 4 – from Redford Pit east to Mulock Road-proposed 2017 upgrades; Mulock Road from Grey Rd. 4 to Concession 2 - proposed 2017 work Last improvement 2010; Bridge #26 Mulock Rd. - review of 2107 work; Concession 2 SDR-review of 2017 work - last improvement 2006

The Director noted that Union Gas is considering potential expansion of natural gas into Chesley & Paisley, and may extend a 10" main along the Concession 2 WGR Road, however, homeowners will not be able to hookup to this main. The Director will ensure security cameras are set up along Mary Rutherford's 10th SDR, to facilitate identifying individuals dumping garbage in the area, in order to fine the individuals.

Rd.- considered for closure; Bridge #50 concession 18 - proposed 2017 work; Bridge #54 concession 16 -proposed 2017 work; Concession 16 – proposed Surface Treating 2017 work; Bridge#66 concession 6 – proposed 2017 work; Letter Breen Road – proposed 2017 work Last improvement 2009; Bridge# 67 – review of safety upgrade requirements.

Glenelg - Concession 2 – review of proposed 2018 work - last improvement 2002; Traverston Bridge – consideration for closure; West back Line – consideration of hard topping upon rationalization review; Hamilton lane – review of 2017 proposed surface treating work; Baptist Church Road – review of 2017 proposed work Last improvement 2004 and 1985; West Grey Pit; Bridge # 37, 38, 39, 48, 40, 41, 43, 44, 45 – review of bridges considered for closure.

Markdale Aggregates Inc., also has interest in purchasing some gravel from the West Grey Pit. The Director will report back to Council on this issue.
