- Safety Guidelines
  - Be very careful out there; Be mentally alert
  - Don't horse around
  - Work shall not be carried out on bridges or other structures where there is an apparent risk of injury
  - Work shall only be carried out in the areas between the outer edges of the shoulders and the right-of-way boundary on either side of the roadway.
  - Do not touch or pickup anything sharp or that you cannot identify. It may be a hazardous item. Please mark the location or provide a note of the location so it can later be collected in a safe manner.
  - Wear footwear with thick soles to prevent foot damage from sharp objects
  - Always work facing traffic
  - Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
  - The Municipality will supply safety vests and pylons to alert ongoing traffic of the road cleanup being conducted. Due to the number of participants we have a limited number of safety vests to supply. If possible please wear florescent clothing so oncoming traffic will identify you easier.
  - No children allowed under the age of thirteen (13)
- The bags are supplied by Pitch-In-Canada; which can be picked up at the Municipal office.
