Five Easy Steps...

1. Are you on the Voters' List? Voter Lookup will tell you.



Accessing voterlookup.ca is easy! To confirm your information is accurately recorded for the upcoming election simply enter your name, date of birth, location, and property address or assessment roll number.

You may also call **1-866-296-6722** to contact Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC), the organization responsible for the preparation of the Preliminary List of Electors.

Voters are encouraged to check if they are on the Voters List for the 2018 Municipal and School Board Elections occurring in October, 2018 by visiting www.voterlookup.ca.

2. In early October, each elector will receive a personal **voter notification letter** containing information to access the voting system by internet or telephone.

AT HOME VOTE USING THE INTERNET OR PHONE Using your assigned Voter ID and PIN (shown below) and your Year of Birth, vote anytime from Friday, October 12th starting at 10:00 am until Monday, October 22nd ending at 8:00 pm. To vote online, go to https://www.evoting.com/SampleID2018 and follow the instructions. To vote by telephone, call the voting telephone number at 1-866-957-1822 and follow the instructions. Please be aware that if you should be interrupted while voting electronically, you may re-access the voting system to complete your voting. By casting a ballot or by entering the electronic PIN and entering your assigned Voter ID and PIN (shown below) and your Year of Birth, you are DECLARING THAT YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE in this election. Vote early to avoid higher volume activity periods near the end of the election period. IMPORTANT INFORMATION			

The letter includes:

- ◆ Your voter ID number
- ◆ Your unique voter PIN number
- ◆ The web address and telephone number for the voting system
- ◆ Important voting information, such as candidates running for office, location of help centres, legal requirements to vote and how to find more information.

Please DO NOT RECYCLE your Voter Identification Letter.

If you do not wish to vote, shred it. Your Voter Identification Letter is your responsibility!

3. Electors will be required to confirm they are entitled to vote when accessing the system. **Users must enter their ID and PIN number** provided on the voter letter. Follow the instructions and confirm his or her selections.

4. **Help Centres** will be located in municipal facilities to promote the election or assist voters. At these facilities electors:

- ◆ Can be added to the Voters' List
- ◆ Receive assistance and clarification on the election process.
- ◆ Access a telephone or computer for voting

- ◆ Normanby Arena Complex
