Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms are now required by law wherever a fuel burning appliance is located in a residence. **Fuel burning includes:** wood, propane, natural gas, oil or kerosene. CO alarms are also required on a wall adjacent to attached garages. Check manufacturer's recommendation for location of installation.



Smoke alarms are required on all levels of a residence and also between the sleeping & living areas of the home.
